Classroom Rules

- ▶ Be Safe
- ▶ Be Respectful
- ▶ Be Responsible

* Students begin each day on the green happy face.

* If a student makes a poor choice, we discuss what happened and what a better choice could be. They will move their name to the yellow face.

* If the behavior continues, the student will have to move their name to the red sad face. I will send home a WOBBL letter (working on better behavior letter). If your child receives a WOBBL letter, please discuss with your child and sign and return the following day.

■ At the the end of the day, each child who is on green will receive 2 stamps. Students on yellow will receive 1 stamp, and those on red will not receive any stamps. This is an excellent way for parents to be informed of their child's behavior for the day. Be sure to look for your child's stamps daily! Rewards for good behavior: verbal praise, stickers, prizes, blue slips, or call/note home.



Reminders

* Please make sure your child's name is on everything. It is especially important to write their name on backpacks, lunch pails, and all outer wear (jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts).

* The first two weeks of kindergarten will be half-days.

* The first two weeks students will be dismissed at 12:40 and 11:40 on Wednesdays.

* No parent volunteers will be needed during the first three weeks of school; this time is spent teaching students how to become more independent as well as teaching our classroom routines and expectations.

* All volunteers must be board approved to be allowed to work with students. Please see the office for the volunteer form.
